Please note that while CFF traps are changed every other week, traps for CM/CFW/OBLR remain in the orchard for the entire season, and only the bottom liners are changed. When you buy one trap, it comes with all the necessary liners for the full season, hence the higher cost. In addition, significantly fewer traps are required to be placed in orchards for CM/CFW/OBLR. Please see page 4 for details on trap requirements.

**In order to remain on the 2024 China approved grower list, growers may wish to register for this program regardless of winter damage to their crop. For 2024, the BCCA proposes to heavily subsidize the cost of this program, dipping into reserves to help growers hit by the recent deep freeze event. Growers will still be responsible for all aspects of this program as outlined in CFIA documents.*

A. *Rhagoletis spp.* - Cherry Fruit Fly - yellow sticky traps for the **China** Export Program and the **Korea** Export Program

Note: Replace traps every 2 weeks and lures every 4 weeks.

Note: Growers in the Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen (RDOS) AND who have only early varieties (ripe before Lapins and Skeena) may choose the three-month option, below. All other growers must choose the four-month trapping schedule.
