I have read, understood and agree to comply with all the requirements outlined in the following documents:

- Canada-Japan Cherry Systems Approach for Export of Canadian Fresh Sweet Cherries from British Columbia to Japan – June 21, 2018

I understand that fresh BC cherry fruit exported to **Thailand** must be free of quarantine pests of concern to Thailand, including: European brown scale (*Parthenolecanium corni*), pear oyster scale (*Diaspidiotus ostreaeformis*), oystershell scale (*Lepidosaphes ulmi*), apple mealybug (*Phenacoccus aceris*), mulberry moth (*Hyphantria cunea*), pearly underwing moth (*Peridroma saucia*), brown rot of fruit (*Monilinia fructigena*), tomato fruit rot (*Phytophthora cryptogea*) and crown rot of apple (*Phytophthora megasperma*).

I understand that fresh BC cherry fruit exported to **PRC** must be free of all pests of quarantine concern to PRC, including: western cherry fruit fly (*Rhagoletis indifferens*), black cherry fruit fly (*Rhagoletis fausta*), apple maggot (*Rhagoletis pomonella*), pruneworm leafroller (*Acrobasis tricolorella*), cherry fruitworm (*Grapholita packardi*), lesser apple worm (*Grapholita prunivora*), large fruit tree tortrix (*Archips podana*), oblique-banded leafroller (*Choristoneura rosaceana*), marbled orchard tortrix (*Hedya nubiferana*), tufted apple bud moth (*Platynota idaeusalis*), black cherry aphid (*Myzus cerasi*), apple mealybug (*Phenacoccus aceris*), brown rot (*Monilinia fructicola*), bacterial canker (*Pseudomonas syringae pv morsprunorum*), and Little Cherry Virus.



Also, of concern is spotted wing drosophila (*Drosophila suzukii*), within acceptable tolerance levels.

I understand that fresh BC cherry fruit exported to **Japan** must be free of all pests of quarantine concern to Japan, including: codling moth (*Cydia pomonella*), cherry fruit flies (*Rhagoletis indifferens*, *R. fausta*), fruitworms (*Grapholita packardi*, *G. prunivora*), peach twig borer (*Anarsia lineatella*), and leafrollers (*Choristoneura rosaceana*, *Archips argyrospila*).

I understand that fresh BC cherry fruit exported to **Korea** must be free of all pests of quarantine concern to Korea, including Cherry Leaf Spot (*Blumeriella jaapii*), Gumspot of Stone Fruit (*Stigmia carpophila*), Western cherry fruit fly (*Rhagoletis indifferens*) Black cherry fruit fly (*Rhagoletis fausta*), Apple maggot (*Rhagoletis pomonella*), Cherry fruitworm (*Grapholita packardi*), Lesser apple worm (*Grapholita prunivora*), Codling moth (*Cydia pomonella*), Peach twig Borer (*Anarsia lineatella*), Orange tortrix moth (*Argryotaenia franciscana*), Oblique-banded leafroller (*Choristoneura rosaceana*), Cherry ring mottle (Prune dwarf virus), Apple curculio (*Anthonomus quadrigibbus*), Fruit tree tortix (*Archips podana*), Common twist moth (*Pandemis cerasana*), Three-lined leafroller (*Pandemis limitata*) Fruit tree leaf roller (*Archips argyrospila*).

I understand that fresh BC cherry fruit exported to the **EU** countries must be free of all pests of quarantine concern to the EU, including: cherry fruit flies (*Rhagoletis indifferens*, *R. fausta*) and cherry fruitworm (*Grapholita packardi*). I understand that *Thaumatotibia leucotreta* (false codling moth) is not present in BC.

I understand that fresh BC cherry fruit exported to the **UK** must be free of cherry fruitworm (*Grapholita packardi*).

I understand that I am responsible for ensuring that other relevant regulations in place in Thailand, PRC, Japan, Korea, EU and UK are met, including Maximum Residue Levels (MRLs) of fresh BC cherries.

As per my signature which follows, I give my consent to the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) to provide the information contained in my application, including my personal information, to the BC Cherry Association. I provide this consent understanding that the BC Cherry Association will only use this information for purposes which relate to my participation in the export of fresh cherries to Thailand, People's Republic of China, Japan, Republic of Korea, European Union and United Kingdom.

I agree that failure to meet any of the requirements of Thailand, People's Republic of China, Japan, Republic of Korea, European Union and United Kingdom as referenced in the *Annual CFIA Guidelines for Pest Monitoring and Pest Management in Registered British Columbia Cherry Orchards – A Systems Approach for Exports to Thailand, People's Republic of China, Japan, Republic of Korea, European Union and United Kingdom*



will result in suspension or removal from the list of registered exporters for these countries and may result in ineligibility to export fresh cherries to any or all of these countries.

- My personal information collected by the Agency under Plant Protection Export Programs will be dealt with under the provisions of the Privacy Act and will be stored in Personal Information Bank CFIA IPP 155 and this information may be accessible or protected as required under the provisions of the Access to Information Act. I also acknowledge that this information will be retained for a period of 10 years in accordance with the Agency's retention and disposition policies.
